

There were three **cash point skimmers** found in the area recently and one on the Framlingham Barclays in 2008. Though the police have pointed out they do vary in appearance, they seem to come in two types;

throat and plate and both have a pinhole camera mounted above the keypad to capture the pin ... nasty.

As long as you cover the keypad from the camera just above it, your PIN should not be recorded (the camera is located in the flat plate that is being held on the left of each of the following pictures). The crooks need both your card details and your PIN to make it all work.
